The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from danger at the hands of accused persons named in FIR No.303 dated 06.09.2022 registered under Sections 120-B, 147, 149, 294, 307, 323, 379-B, 452 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is running a Dera in Village Sanchla, Tehsil Tohana, District Fatehabad which is a religious place. The accused persons in the above-said FIR are threatening the petitioner to kill him and on 06.09.2022 the accused persons along with other unknown persons forcible entered into the Dera and started beating the persons present in the Dera as well as the petitioner and caused injuries to them and damaged the property of the Dera. Learned counsel further submits that in view of imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioner, petitioner has moved representations dated 10.09.2022, 13.09.2022 and 30.01.2023

(Annexures P-5 to P-7) to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police Fatehabad but not action has been taken so far,

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Munish Sharma, Asstt. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that directions may be given to respondent No.2 to look into the representations made by the petitioners.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad to look into the representations 10.09.2022, 13.09.2022 and 30.01.2023 (Annexures P-5 to P-7) of the petitioner and take appropriate action in accordance with law.
