This is a petition seeking regular bail in FIR No.224, dated 15.10.2020, under Sections 302, 323, 341, 201, 427, 34 of IPC, 1860 (Section 34 of IPC deleted and Sections 148 & 149 added later on), registered at Police Station Shahzadpur, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the contends that no injury attributed to the petitioner and he has been falsely implicated in the present case. He further submits that co-accused namely Mandeep Singh has been granted bail vide order dated 06.02.2023 (Annexure P-4) passed in CRM-M-4930-2023.

Learned State counsel has produced the custody certificate of the petitioner, which is taken on record. He could not controvert the said fact.

Mr. Naresh Kumar Khepar, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of complainant and has filed power of attorney, which is taken on

record.

Considering of the aforesaid facts and circumstances that no injury attributed to the petitioner and co-accused has already been granted the concession of bail vide order dated 06.02.2023 (Annexure P-4), the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The present petition is, hereby, allowed.
