The challenge in the present appeal is to the order dated 04.07.2022 whereby the anticipatory bail of the petitioners was declined in FIR No.29 dated 24.03.2022 under Sections 341, 323, 34 IPC, later on added Section 3 of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (Amendment 2015) registered at P.S.Majitha, District Amritsar..

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 24.02.2023 passed by this Court, appellants have joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the appellants have joined investigation in terms of orders dated 24.02.2023 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 24.02.2023 is made absolute.

However, the appellants shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Appeal stands disposed of.
