1. The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.305 dated 24.11.2022, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Jandiala, Police District Amritsar Rural, District Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, has submitted that the arrest of the petitioner was stayed by this Court on 21.03.2023 and it is almost one year and four months that the police has not even issued notice or *Parwana* to the petitioner and therefore there was no occasion for the petitioner to have joined investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sikander Lal, has stated that the police will not take any action against the petitioner without complying with the guidelines laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Arnesh Kumar versus State of Bihar and another 2014(3) RCR (Criminal) 527** since the offence is registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in view of the

statement made by learned State counsel, he does not wish to press this petition at this stage and prays for withdrawal.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn.
