ALOK JAIN, J. :

Prayer in the present petition is for seeking direction to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.4, on the basis of the allegation that FIR No.5, dated 03.02.2023, under Section 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women, District Amritsar, has been transferred to Police Station B Division, Amritsar and the only reason for apprehension is that the petitioner had approached this Court on earlier occasion, wherein he had specifically stated that he has threat perception from one SI Amritpal Singh, posted in Police Station B Division.

At the outset, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Inderjit Singh, Police Station Women Cell, Amritsar, submits that SI Amritpal Singh, is not the Investigating Officer in the present matter and the case is being investigated by Police Station Women Cell-1, Amritsar.

Learned State counsel has further submitted that the petitioner has already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail and has to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation. Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner should abide by the terms and conditions of the anticipatory bail granted to him. Accordingly, he submits that nothing survives in the present petition, at this stage.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition be dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.
