By way of this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.150 dated 30.09.2022 registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Division No.3, Ludhiana.

Today, status report has been filed along with the custody certificate. Petitioner is in custody for the last 04 months and 22 days.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has also placed on record copy of order dated 22.02.2023 passed by this Court in CRM-M-9025 of 2023 to contend that matter has been compromised between the main accused and the complainant and parties have been directed to appear before the trial Court for getting their statements recorded.

Allegations against the petitioner are that her fake Adhaar Card and Pan Card were used in the name of Roop Kaur, in order to sell certain property to the complainant.

Case is triable by Magistrate. Custody certificate does not reveal any criminal antecedents of the petitioner, who is in custody for the last more than 04 months. Case has already been compromised

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between the complainant and the main accused. No purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner detained.

Considering all the above circumstances, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is admitted to bail on her furnishing personal bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.
