This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by the petitioner for issuance of direction to the official respondents No.1 to 4 to conduct inquiry and fair trial in case bearing FIR No.0053 dated 27.06.2019 under Sections 447, 427, 341, 379, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Rangar Nangal, Batala, District Gurdaspur.

On issuance of notice of motion, short reply by way of affidavit of Jasvir Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Detective, Batala of Sub Division Sri Hargobindpur, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur has been filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4, which is already taken on record. In Para No.5 of the reply it has been stated as under:-

“ That, it is humbly submitted that the challan/final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. was prepared against accused Ajit Singh S/o Hazara Singh, Gian Singh S/o Hazara Singh, Kawalpreet Singh S/o Gian Singh, Amandeep Singh @ Amarbir Singh S/o Tarlok Singh, Akashdeep Singh S/o Kawalpreet Singh residents of Ammo Nangal, Tehsil Batala, District Gurdaspur and presented in the ld. court on 31.03.2022. In the present case there are 13 prosecution witnesses and now the case

is pending in the 1d. court of Ms. Vineeta Luthra, SDJM Batala and fixed for 01.03.2023 for framing charge.”

Learned State counsel submits that since the matter has already been investigated and final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been filed before the trial court on 31.03.2022 and even the charges have been framed on 14.06.2022 and now the case is fixed for 29.03.2023.

In view of the above, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of accordingly.
