SANJEEV PRAKASH SHARMA, J (ORAL)

1. By way of this writ petition, the petitioner prays to direct the respondents to consider his case for Compassionate Appointment. He relies on the order passed by a Co-ordinate Bench on 13.04.2023, where similar cases were disposed of by the Co-ordinate Bench directing the members of the Committee constituted by the State for considering claim of the persons for Compassionate Appointment.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the State does not object if the case is disposed of in the same terms.

3. Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of in terms of order passed in CWP No.12796 of 2017, decided on 13.04.2023 along with other connected matters and it is directed that Committee constituted by the State for considering the cases for Compassionate Appointment shall consider the case of the petitioner and pass appropriate orders within a period of eight weeks and communicate the same to the petitioner.

4. If the petitioner is still aggrieved, he may take appropriate remedies in law.
