Present writ petition has been filed seeking writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to conclude the disciplinary proceedings initiated against the petitioner vide charge sheet dated 23.09.2019 (Annexure P-1) and that dated 12.06.2020 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the inquiry proceedings were initiated in both the charge-sheets more than 2 years ago and yet the same are not being concluded.
