Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.149 dated 22.12.2022, under Section 406 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Kotwali Nabha, District Patiala.

Vide order dated 21.03.2023, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that pursuant to order dated 21.03.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation. He further submits that the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and as per the agreement arrived at between the parties, the petitioner has made full and final payment of Rs.25,000/- to the complainant.

Complainant is also present in person in the Court and has affirmed the fact that as per the compromise arrived at between them, petitioner has made complete payment.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Gurkirat Kaur, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 21.03.2023 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
