The prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.1025, dated 17.11.2022, under Section 174-A of IPC, registered at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had already challenged the order dated 15.10.2022 passed by the trial Court, whereby he was declared proclaimed person in complaint case, in CRM-M No.3037 of 2023, decided on 19.01.2023 in which the petitioner was granted 15 days time to surrender and move an application for bail before the trial Court and the same would be decided on same day. But the Court had already registered the above-said case bearing FIR No.1025, dated 17.11.2022 on the ground that the petitioner was declared proclaimed person.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Karan Sharma, DAG, Haryana, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A copy of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court/Duty magistrate within 15 days and move an application for bail. The same shall be decided on the same day.
