1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Section 2 read with Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 27.10.2021 passed in CRM-M-44736-2021.
2. In compliance of this court's order dated 13.07.2023, status report dated 17.08.2023 by way of affidavit of Narendra Bijarniya, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Nuh, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Fresh status report dated 05.12.2023 as asked by this court's order dated 21.08.2023, by way of affidavit of Narendra Bijarniya, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Nuh, filed in the Court today, is also taken on record.
4. The order, qua which the contempt is alleged, is of the nature, for alleged non-compliance of which the contempt proceedings cannot be initiated.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
6. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
