Present writ petition has been filed for directing the respondents to carry out necessary correction in the revenue record with respect to a drain running in village Ryatpur, Tehsil Nakodar, District Jalandhar in the facts and circumstances of the present case so as to enable the proper demarcation of the land of petitioner as well as the drain flowing in the village.

After issuance of notice of motion, State has filed the reply.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Jivesh Gupta, SDO, Water Resources Department, has submitted before this Court that necessary correction as prayed for by the petitioner in the present petition has already been carried out on 14.03.2023. He submits that as the grievance of the petitioner is redressed, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel that grievance of the petitioner has already been redressed, the present petition is dismissed as infructuous. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail his remedy in accordance with law in case he has any surviving cause of action.
