HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0238, dated 27.03.2022, under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 324, 341 of the IPC, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 (Section 216 of IPC, 1860 added later on) registered at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

Vide order dated 14.02.2023 passed by a Coordinate Bench, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 14.02.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Pawan, submits

that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 14.02.2023 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
