The instant petition had although been filed for seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to ensure the protection of life and liberty of the petitioner from implication in false cases regarding issuance/renewable of arms licenses in the area of Districts Tarn Taran and Amritsar, however, when the matter was listed for hearing on 17.02.2020, the petitioner restricted his prayer to seek a detailed list of Arms licenses issued/renewed during the period 2008-09, statedly dealt with by him as a Class-IV employee.

Reply by way of short affidavit of Sh. Rishi Pal Singh, Deputy Commissioner, Tarn Taran has already been filed. A copy thereof has been handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner. Along with the reply, the list of Arms Licenses prepared by Baljit Singh, as a Clerk in the Arms

License Branch w.e.f. 30.04.2008 to 17.07.2009, when he was posted there has been appended along with the present response.

In view of the information having been furnished by respondent No.3-The Deputy Commissioner, Tarn Taran along with his reply dated 16.01.2023, no further directions are required to be called for in the present writ petition. The same is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
