The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.39 dated 21.01.2023 registered under Section 174-A IPC at Police Station Sector-36, Chandigarh.

By virtue of the order dated 15.02.2023, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated. He submits that costs of Rs.10,000/- as directed by this Court has also been deposited by the petitioner and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Yashpal, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submitted that he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 15.02.2023 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
