Petitioners have approached this Court praying for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.3 and 4 by summoning them again and again in connection with the inquiry in the complaint/representation dated 29.07.2022 (Annexure P-1).

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that respondents No.5 to 9 gave a complaint to the police and the inquiry was conducted in the same by Special Detective Staff, Panipat and petitioners duly joined and were found innocent as well. He submits that thereafter the petitioners in compliance of notice from Deputy Superintendent of Police, Samalkhan, District Panipat went to his office on 01.12.2022 along with other persons from Moga City. He submits that thereafter when they came out of the office of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Samalkhan, District Panipat, they were threatened on the gun point by respondents No.5 to 9. He submits that no action has been taken by the police for their protection and the petitioners have serious threat to their

life and liberty. He has further submitted that the inquiry against the petitioners are going on in District Panipat and Karnal.

Notice of motion to respondents no.1 to 3-State only.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Mr. B.S. Virk, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file their appropriate representation before Superintendent to Police, Panipat and Superintendent of Police, Karnal within two weeks for redressal of their grievances and if the same is filed then the concerned Superintendent of Police would decide the same in accordance with law within two weeks thereafter.
