1. On 15.02.2023, following order was passed:

“Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.50 dated 03.04.2011 under Sections 323/324/326/506/341/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations with regard to inflicting injuries on the person of the complainant have been attributed to two unknown persons. At the time of occurrence, the petitioner was residing in UK. The petitioner was declared proclaimed offender in terms of the order dated 15.11.2012. The operation of the said order has been stayed in terms of the order dated November 09, 2022 passed in CRM-M-5669-2020, which is still pending.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Ruchika Sabherwal, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Adjourned to 23.02.2023.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with **CRM-M-5669-2020.** ”

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the interim directions, the petitioner has surrendered in the trial Court and has been admitted on bail. Although, the petitioner has gone abroad subsequently but after getting permission from the Court and furnishing requisite surety as directed by the trial Court.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kabal Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid factual aspect.

4. Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 15.02.2023 is made absolute.
