MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

By means of this writ petition filed under Article 226 Constitution of India petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 09.02.2023 (Annexure P-6), whereby his services as Director have been terminated. Further, prayer is for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to continue on the selected post.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that as the regular incumbent held lien to the post of Director of respondent No.3-Institution, and he decided to join back, the service of the petitioner was terminated w.e.f.13.02.2023, but at that stage, even the terms and conditions of the appointment letter were not complied with.

At this stage, Mr. Chatrath, learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 and 3 states that the impugned order itself gives the justifiable reasons for petitioner's termination. He further states that the terms and conditions contained in the appointment letter dated 27.11.2019 (Annexure P-2) would be

complied with and the admissible dues would be paid to the petitioner.

Faced with the above stand of Mr. Chatrath, learned counsel, Mr. Saini, learned counsel for petitioner does not press this petition and prays for withdrawal of the same.

The prayer is accepted.

The petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn.
