The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.19 dated 22.1.2023 registered under sections 21/29 of NDPS Act at Police Station, Sadar Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Vide order dated 16.2.2023 passed by this court, petitioner was granted interim bail and he was directed to join investigation. Thereafter, this case came up for hearing on 22.5.2023 and it was brought to the notice of the court that petitioner did not join investigation. Petitioner was again directed to join investigation before the IO on 25.5.2023 at 10 AM.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Charanjeet has informed the court that petitioner has not yet joined investigation as he is involved in one more case and thus apprehends his arrest in that case. However, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was not allowed to join investigation.

In view of the above position, this court finds that petitioner has not complied with the order passed and resultantly he does not deserve the concession of bail. Accordingly, present petition is dismissed.
