ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking a direction for setting aside the impugned order dated 20.01.2023 passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Amritsar whereby his evidence has been closed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is only seeking two effective opportunities to lead his evidence. The evidence could not be led earlier due to Covid-19 pandemic and ill-health of the petitioner, who is stated to be 66 years old.

In view of the limited prayer of the petitioner, the petition is being disposed of without issuance of notice to the respondents. It would be in the interest of justice, if the petitioner is granted two effective opportunities to lead his evidence.

Consequently, the petition is allowed and the impugned order dated 20.01.2023 is set aside. The petitioner would be afforded two effective opportunities to lead his evidence. In the event of the respondents being aggrieved of this order, they would be at liberty to file an application.
