On 23.02.2023, the following order was passed in this case:-

'Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced dasti summons issued to the respondent. As per report, Service is complete. However, none has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 14.02.2023, following order was passed:-

"The challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 10.10.2022 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Court of learned JMIC, Chandigarh, whereby, while rejecting the exemption application of the petitioner, his bail has been cancelled and bail bonds and surety bonds furnished by the petitioner has also been cancelled and forfeited to the State and nonailable warrants have been issued and the order dated

07.01.2023 (Annexure P-5), whereby, the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed person.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is 57 years old lady suffering from heart disease. He further submits that the petitioner has been regularly appearing except for certain dates for which applications for exemption were filed which were allowed and vide impugned order, while rejecting his exemption application, his bail was cancelled and non-bailable warrants were issued. He further submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court.

Notice of motion for 23.02.2023.

Process be given dasti only.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and will furnish fresh bail/surety bonds and she may be granted interim bail.

On her appearance before the trial Court within a week, she be admitted on interim bail subject to her furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court till the adjourned date of hearing.

Adjourned to 28.04.2023 for further consideration”.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance to the aforementioned order, the petitioner has surrendered before the Court of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Chandigarh and has since been admitted to bail as is borne out from the order dated 01.03.2023. A copy of the said order is taken on record as Mark ‘A’.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. Disposed of.
