Instant writ petition has been filed inter-alia seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to verify the details of the petitioners and to submit them as per the guidelines issued by the Government of Haryana under the Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam Policy.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners No.1 and 2 were engaged as Data Entry Operator and petitioner No.3 was engaged as a Supervisor in the Public Health Department, and they were replaced by another set of contractual employees on 24.11.2021. Counsel submits that pursuant to memorandum dated 22.11.2021, Annexure P-3, respondents No.4 and 5 were required to upload and submit the data of all the contractual employees, working under them, on the web portal of meraparivar. Counsel submits that despite the fact that the data of the

petitioners has been uploaded, but it has neither been updated, nor submitted on the web portal of Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam and the petitioner are being deprived of the deployment policy formulated by the Government. She submits that the petitioners have submitted a legal notice dated 27.01.2023, Annexure P-6, but no action has been taken. Counsel submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent concerned to look into the same.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. R.K.S.Brar, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Given the nature of order being passed, this Court does not deem it necessary to call for a response from the respondent.

Having heard counsel for the parties, but without examining the grievance of the petitioners as raised in the writ petition or in the legal notice, Annexure P-6, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.4 and 5 to examine the legal notice dated 27.01.2023, Annexure P-6, update and submit the data of the petitioners within a period of four weeks from the date of communication of copy of this order, in case, there is no legal impediment in doing so.
