1. The original Aadhar Card of the applicant Priya Sharya has been seen, and, returned. Photocopy of the said Aadhar Card, signed by the applicant has been retained on record as 'Mark-A'.
2. During the pendency of the instant application, before this Court, the applicant appears in person, and, has recorded her statement on oath, which has been read over, and, explained to her, and, whereafter she appended her signatures thereons. The applicant has stated therein, that she does not press for annulment of the ex-parte decree, as passed by the learned trial Judge concerned, on a Hindu Marriage Petition bearing No. 88 of 21.5.2010, given hers entering into a compromise with the respondent, one Manish Sharma. She has further stated therein, that she do not press, the instant application seeking leave to appeal against the verdict of acquittal, as made by the learned Magistrate concerned, upon Complaint No. RBT-15/2.7.12/11.1.17, and, states that the verdict of acquittal as made, upon the case (supra), be maintained and affirmed.

3. In view of the above statement of the applicant, the instant application bearing CRM-A-1502-MA-2017, seeking leave to appeal against the verdict of acquittal, as made by the learned Magistrate concerned, upon the case (supra), is dismissed. The impugned verdict of acquittal, is affirmed, and, maintained.

4. No order as to costs.

5. Records, if any requisitioned from the learned trial Court concerned, be sent down forthwith.

6. Bail bonds, if any furnished by the respondents, are ordered to be forthwith cancelled, and, discharged.
