The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the order dated 25.01.2017 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Ferozepur in case FIR No.155 dated 20.06.2015 registered under Sections 21/25/29 of NDPS Act, Sections 489-A, B, C IPC, Section 25 of Arms Act and Section 3 of OS Act at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, whereby an application filed by the petitioner for releasing a vehicle bearing Registration No.PJM 9033 on *Superdari* has been dismissed.

A short reply dated 31.01.2023 by way of an affidavit of Surinder Pal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (City), Ferozepur has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record.

The learned State counsel submits that three accused including the present petitioner have been acquitted in the Trial held pursuant to FIR No.155 dated 20.06.2015. Only one of the accused namely Amritpal Singh has been convicted and has since filed an appeal

which is pending adjudication before this Court. He submits that the vehicle in question has been handed over to the petitioner vide DDR No.38 dated 21.12.2020.

Faced with this, the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition it having been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as infructuous.
