By way of this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.199, dated 17.12.2022, registered at Police Station Division 4, District Patiala, under Sections 419, 420, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC.

Attribution against the petitioner is that she identified one Ashok Kumar in the Court, who stood surety for one accused Amarjit Singh @ Raju @ Prema Ram in case FIR No.343, dated 20.10.2014, under Sections 379 and 411 IPC, registered at Police Station Tripuri, Patiala, and on that identification, surety bonds were accepted. Later on, accused absconded and declared proclaimed offender, proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C. against the surety were initiated and it emerged that there was no person by the name of Ashok Kumar.

This is not a case where the allegations against the petitioner appears to be unfounded. No case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
