This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.190 dated 05.12.2022 (Annexure P-1) under Section 21(b) of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kabarwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, Punjab.

In para No.8 of the petition, it has been averred that there is no case/FIR against the petitioner, except FIR No.62 dated 14.07.2019 under Sections 21/29 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Phase-4, SAS Nagar, Mohali, FIR No.124 dated 13.09.2019 under Section 21 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Phase-11, SAS Nagar, Mohali and the petitioner is not a proclaimed offender and is in custody.

However, learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate wherein another case FIR No.80 dated 01.01.2007 under Section 21 of NDPS Act, Police Station B Division, has also been mentioned in which the petitioner has been convicted by the Court of Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar vide judgment dated 02.06.2012 and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 10 years with fine of Rs.1,00,000/- and in default rigorous imprisonment for 1 year and he has been bailed out on 28.08.2015.

Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action with better particulars at an appropriate stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
