The petitioner herein seeks a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release his salary for the period w.e.f. 01.07.2019 to 29.02.2020, along with interest @ 18% per annum.

At the very outset, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would submit that in this regard, he has already submitted a representation dated 04.02.2020, Annexure P-5, to respondent No.3 herein, but the same has not been decided as yet. Counsel would submit that the petitioner would be satisfied in case the said representation is decided in a time bound manner, in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Dushyant Saharan, Advocate, has put in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Let adequate number of copies of complete paper book be supplied to the counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents during the course of day.

Without commenting on merits of the case and keeping in view the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide representation dated 04.02.2020, Annexure P-5, of the petitioner within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
