1. The petitioner, through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is seeking direction to respondent No.1 to re-issue his passport.
2. Affidavit dated 18.08.2023 of Mandeep Singh, P.P.S, Assistant Commissioner of Police (West), Ludhiana filed on behalf of respondent-State is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place.
3. Mr. Gurmeet Singh Saini, learned counsel for the petitioner on being confronted with the fact that police report under Section 173 Cr.P.C stands presented and matter is pending before the Trial Court, seeks liberty to withdraw the present petition and approach the Trial

Court in view of Notification No.570 dated 25.08.1993 issued by Central Government.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
5. If the petitioner moves an application before the Trial Court in terms of the aforesaid notification, the Trial Court is requested to pass an appropriate order expeditiously in terms of aforesaid notification.
