This criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and family members endangered at the hands of accused/respondents No.5 to 8 and to take legal action on the representation dated 19.01.2023 (Annexure P-3) pending before the official respondents.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Adhiraj Singh, AAG, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 4-State. Copy of the paper book be supplied during the course of the day.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur, to consider and decide the representations dated 19.11.2022 and 19.01.2023 (Annexures P-2 and P-3, respectively) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioners seeking protection for their life and liberty along with their family members.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim

of the petitioners and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.3 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioners.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.
