This order shall dispose of two writ petitions bearing ***CWP-1657-1997*** titled “*SURINDER KUMAR VERSUS STATE OF HARYANA AND OTHERS*” and ***CWP-5810-1997*** titled “*RAVINDER PRAKASH AND OTHRES VERSUS STATE OF HARYANA AND OTHERS*” by a common judgment.
