Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the present petition has been filed for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner but the petitioner will be satisfied in case the present petition is disposed of having been not pressed any further but with the direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial in a time bound manner as the petitioner is behind the bars for the last three years and six months.

Ms. Vibha Tewari, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that as per her instructions, out of the total 15 cited witnesses, 08 witnesses have already been examined and 04 witnesses have been summoned for 09.03.2023 and states that she has no objection in case the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial in a time bound manner.

Keeping in view the fact that out of the total 15 cited witnesses, 08 witnesses have already been examined and 04 witnesses have been summoned for 09.03.2023, the present petition is disposed of having been not pressed any further with the direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial within a period of four months from the next date of hearing even if, the same is to be done by giving short adjournments. In case any of the witness is not appearing, proper method as envisaged under law be undertaken for securing the presence of the said witness so as to conclude the trial within a time frame.
