1 This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.434 dated 14.07.2021 registered under Sections 395/397 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act (Sections 420/120-B IPC added lateron) at Police Station City Palwal, District Palwal.

2 Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been nominated on the basis of a disclosure statement made in FIR No.0471 dated 30.07.2021 registered for offences punishable under Sections 399/402 IPC read with Section 25 of the Arms Act and even that case i.e. the said FIR was registered on the basis of information of the informer that the petitioner is planning to commit some *dacoity*. The petitioner is behind bars since 30.07.2021. Challan already stands presented and thus there can not be any apprehension that the petitioner shall tamper with the evidence.

3 Learned State counsel is not in a position to dispute the
aforementioned factual assertions based on record.

4 I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone
through the records of the case.

5 Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering
the incarceration suffered by the petitioner and the fact that there is no
apprehension that the petitioner shall tamper with the evidence, the present
petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his
furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty
Magistrate, concerned.

6 Needless to say that anything observed herein shall not be
construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case.
