Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing order dated 31.12.2020, Annexure P-2, vide which, petitioner was relieved/terminated after attaining the age of 58 years from Group-D post. Direction has been sought to the respondents to allow the petitioner to continue to work till the age of her retirement as per law.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner continued in service pursuant to interim order passed by this Court. He submits that she has attained the age of 60 years, her service has been dispensed with vide order dated 25.11.2022 and she has retired on 31.12.2022. Counsel submits that the petitioner has not been paid the salary for a few months.

In view of above, petition has become infructuous and is dismissed as such.

In case, petitioner has any other grievance, liberty is granted to her to move an appropriate representation before the competent authority, who will pass an appropriate order within four months from the date of submission of representation.
