The grievance of the petitioner in the present petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, 1950 is for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing official respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 9 and to decide the representation dated 06.02.2023 (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court Mr. Sarabjit Singh Cheema, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and submits that the mobile number given in the petition as well as in the representation is not available, and therefore, the petitioner should approach the respondent No.2.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he will be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 and 3 to decide her representation dated 06.02.2023, which is annexed as Annexure P-1 with this petition.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, District Ludhiana, Punjab and respondent No.3-SHO, Police Station Dehlon, District Ludhiana to decide the representation dated 06.02.2023 (Annexure P-1) expeditiously on the receipt of certified copy of this order, and if any threat perception is found, take appropriate steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner. This order shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
