The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to take legal action against respondents No.3 and 4, who are alleged to have attempted forcible recovery of the truck/vehicle of the petitioner bearing Registration No.PB-04-AB-0927) with the help of recovery agents and also in violation of the notification dated 28.09.2006 (Annexure P-2) issued by the Reserve Bank of India as also the judicial pronouncement on the issue.

The written statement on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 has already been filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the matter stands already settled between the petitioner and respondent-Bank and that the grievance does not subsist any further.

The instant petition is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
