JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

This is a petition that has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the revised Pension Payment Order dated 06.07.2016 (Annexure P-2), wherein the qualifying service of the petitioner for retiral benefits has been counted from the date of CPF deduction i.e. 01.03.1985 and not from the date of joining i.e. 01.03.1984.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer to the extent that respondents be directed to treat the instant writ petition as representation on behalf of the petitioner and the same be decided expeditiously. He would submit that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a decision is taken on the representation in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to official respondents only.

Mr. Kapil Bansal, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice for the official respondents and submits that the official respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner. Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondents to treat the instant writ petition as the representation of the petitioner and decide the same within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
