As per affidavit of the DSP, Vigilance Bureau, Unit Bathinda, which is on record, it is stated that the Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda has passed an order on 05.01.2023 directing the release of goods, seized by the police, on *superdari*, however, the State of Punjab filed a petition bearing CRM-M-9264-2023 before this Court and vide order dated 18.05.2023, some modifications have been made in the aforesaid order and finally, on 22.05.2023, 75 articles were released on *superdari* to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Rule stands discharged.

The petitioner is granted liberty to avail the alternative remedy, in accordance with law, if so advised.
