Status report by way of affidavit of Shri Satvinder Singh Virk, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jagraon, District Ludhiana (Rural) on behalf of the respondent-State, along with copy of statement of Avtar Singh, recorded on 13.05.2023 has been filed.

As per the said statement of Avtar Singh, petitioner No.1 got the house transferred in her name by taking the benefit of his illness. However, as noticed in the order dated 17.02.2023, the sale deed in question was executed way back on 05.09.2014 whereas FIR has been lodged on 22.12.2022 i.e. after a gap of more than eight years.

For the reasons mentioned in the order dated 17.02.2023 and the fact that the petitioners have already joined the investigation, the order dated 17.02.2023 is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioners shall continue to join the investigation, if and so required by the IO.
