The petitioner is alleging violation of the order dated 01.12.2022, passed by this Court in CRM-M-55303-2022, vide which, a direction was issued to the investigating agency to conclude the investigation within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the said order.

As per affidavit of the Assistant Inspector General of Police, NRI Wing, Amritsar, which is on record, a compliance report dated 23.12.2022 is attached and by giving details of the investigation, it is submitted that two persons were found innocent and the husband has already been arrested, whereas look out notice has been issued against two persons, i.e. father-in-law and mother-in-law, under Section 105-B Cr.P.C. and the challan will be presented only after completion of proceedings against two persons, who are residing abroad, however, learned State counsel submits that proceedings qua aforesaid two persons, who are residing abroad will be segregated and the challan qua other accused will be

presented within a period of one month from today.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Rule stands discharged.

The petitioner is granted liberty to revive the present petition, if the challan is not presented within the aforesaid time.
