Grievance raised by the petitioner in this writ petition is that an ordinary meeting of the Zila Parishad is being held without proper composition of the Zila Parishad. Specifically reference is made to Section 118 of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 (for short 'the Act') to submit that without the Vice President of the Zila Parishad being elected first, meeting in question cannot be held.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State, on instructions from Mr. Hukam Singh, DDPO, District Nuh, informs that election for the post of Vice President, Zila Parishad, Nuh, is scheduled to be held on 20.02.2023 and till the Vice President is elected, ordinary meeting of the Zila Parishad,

scheduled to be held on 16.02.2023, shall be postponed. In this view of the matter, present writ petition, it is submitted, is rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no notice for election to the post of Vice President, Zila Parishad, Nuh, has been issued in accordance with law as seven (07) days clear notice is required under Rules 76 and 77 of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Election Rules, 1994, therefore, this writ petition should be kept pending. However, we find no justification for the same, keeping in view the specific prayer in this writ petition.

Writ petition is accordingly disposed of as infructuous. Needless to say, election to the post of Vice President, Zila Parishad, Nuh, be conducted in accordance with law.
