The petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.266, dated 19.11.2022, registered at Police Station Udyog Vihar, Gurugram, under Sections 409 & 34 IPC.

According to the FIR, the petitioner stole used newspapers and magazines from the post office and sold them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody for over 03 months. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as only charges have been framed as yet. There is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner. Thus, he may be granted regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 11.03.2023 digitally signed by Sh.Satya Bhan, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Gurugram has been filed in Court. The same is taken on record. A perusal thereof shows that the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 03 months and 21 days and there is no other criminal case pending against him.

Learned State counsel concedes that only charges have been framed as yet.

Taking all the aforementioned facts cumulatively, I deem it appropriate to grant the petitioner regular bail. Accordingly, the petition is allowed. He is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
