ALOK JAIN, J. :

Prayer in the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners by providing adequate security and further directing respondents No.4 to 6, not to harass the petitioners by calling time and again to the police station in FIR No.07, dated 18.01.2023, under Sections 376 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Kheri Nodh Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib, against the husband of petitioner No.1 and son of petitioners No.2 and 3 namely Gurkarandeep Singh @ Roban.

After arguing at length and finding that the Court is not inclined, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, the petitioners are directed to fully co-operate in the investigation by the police in bringing the accused to

join the investigation. It is further directed that the petitioners shall not leave their place of residence without informing the concerned police authorities and their mobile phones shall not be switched off at any point of time with their locations switched on every time.
