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DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

(1) The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 44 dated 09.07.2015 registered under Sections 307, 324, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, District Gurdaspur and all proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioners, on the basis of a written compromise (Annexure P-2).

(2) At the outset, learned State counsel submits that after investigation petitioners No.2 and 3 have been found innocent.

(3) In the light of the afore statement, the present petition qua petitioners No.2 and 3 has been rendered infructuous.

(4) So far as petitioner No.1 is concerned, since the impugned FIR is for an offence of attempt to murder, in which the injured has suffered serious injuries and who has also not been arrayed as a respondent, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners seeks to withdraw the present petition qua petitioner No.1 to take up the issues raised in the present petition before the trial court at an appropriate stage.

(5) Dismissed as withdrawn.

(6) In the peculiar circumstances of the present case, the trial court is directed to dispose of petitioner No.1's trial expeditiously.
