Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.62 dated 21.6.2020 registered under Sections 148, 379-B, 392, 452, 473, 506, 149 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Division D, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

As per allegations recorded in the FIR, 4 unknown persons entered the jewellery shop and forcibly took away 76 grams of gold from there by showing firearms and other weapons to the persons who were there in the said shop.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the previous order of interim bail passed by Coordinate Bench of this court, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police. State counsel on instructions from SI Rakesh Kumar apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and that 3 other persons are

already arrested in this case from whom certain quantity of gold has been recovered and after completion of investigation, the police has presented the challan against the said three persons and is going to present supplementary challan against the present petitioner very shortly. State counsel has not disputed the fact that the petitioner is having no criminal history and that FIR in the present case was registered against 4 unknown persons.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 7.4.2021 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
