1. In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that she was working as a staff nurse and she had applied for child care leave for a period of one month.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after availing the said leave, the petitioner is not being allowed to join her duty which is causing prejudice to her. Learned counsel further submits that for the last 2 years despite issuing notice of motion, the respondents have not filed reply. Hence, the petitioner prays that her representation dated 11.06.2018, which is for the same prayer as raised in the present petition, be decided in a time bound manner so that the petitioner does not suffer any further prejudice.
3. Learned State counsel submits that the representation dated 11.06.2018, Annexure P-8, will be decided within a period of 8 weeks from today by passing appropriate speaking order.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further at this stage.
