This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari declaring the action of the respondents in demolishing the shops of the petitioner as illegal, unjust, arbitrary and unconstitutional.

Learned State counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.1, 2, 4 and 6 has pointed out that in the present case, notices have been issued to the petitioner on 12.01.2023 and thereafter on 19.01.2023 under Section 261 of the Haryana Municipal Corporation Act, 1994 and the said notices have also been affixed on the shops in question and it is thereafter, that after taking police help, the said action has been taken and there is no mention in the entire present petition with respect to the said

notices or about the said facts.

Learned counsel for the petitioner in view of the above seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to initiate fresh proceedings after incorporating and annexing the notices and other relevant documents, in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
