By way of this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.64 dated 10.04.2022 registered under Sections 307/324/323/506/148/149/120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot (Sections 326/325 IPC added later on).

Custody certificate placed on record by learned State Counsel reveals that the petitioner has already undergone actual custody of 09 months and 20 days and that the petitioner has no criminal antecedents.

The only role attributed to the petitioner is that he was armed with kapa and he gave kapa blow towards Mahinder Singh hitting him on his left bicep and then gave another blow hitting on his left side of the neck on upper side of the shoulder.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has also drawn attention towards order dated 21.12.2022 passed in CRM-M-58444 of 2022 whereby a co-ordinate Bench of this Court had granted regular bail to co-

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accused Sukhman Singh alias Kaka. Another co-accused Rachpal Singh
has also been allowed regular bail by this Court vide order dated
31.01.2023 in CRM-M-2748 of 2023.

Having regard to all the aforesaid facts and circumstances,
but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present
petition is allowed. Petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing
personal bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief
Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.
