Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to issue appointment letter to the petitioner on compassionate ground to a post for which she is qualified.

Upon instructions from Sh.Satish Kumar, Assistant Accounts, counsel for respondent No.2 submits that Manpreet Kaur (present petitioner) has been appointed on the post of Peon, vide appointment letter dated 07.12.2022 and she has joined the post on 09.12.2022.

Insofar as the petition is concerned, same has become infructuous.

During pendency of the petition, CM.No.11848 of 2022 has been filed by the mother of the deceased for being impleaded as a party. A submission was made by the applicant that she is entitled to the service benefits of the deceased.

Upon instructions from respondent No.2, Mr.Khehar submits that Daljeet Singh, father of the deceased, is the nominee as per the record available to them.

Despite the fact that Mandeep Singh, Peon, expired on 03.08.2021, his service benefits have not been released.

In view of the above, writ petition is disposed of. It is expected that service benefits of the deceased will be released in favour of his nominee within a period of three months from the date of passing of this order.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
