This is an application for placing on record the Annexures A-1 and A-2.

MAIN CASES

A batch of 09 petitions is being decided by a common order as identical issues are involved therein and counsel for the parties agree that they may be disposed of together.

All these petitions have been filed by the petitioners-shop allottees in the Bathinda Military Station for seeking quashing of vacation orders/notices issued to them for handing over the vacant possession of the shops.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that they have been in actual physical possession of the said shops and have been carrying out their business since the date of allotment; and they would require some reasonable time to hand over the vacant physical possession of the said shops. He further undertakes on behalf of the petitioners that they shall hand over the actual physical possession of the vacant shops to the respondent-Authority on or before 01.04.2024.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid offer made by learned counsel for the petitioners and balancing the equities and in order to avoid the

multiplicity of litigation and futility of the said exercise, the present petitions are disposed of accordingly.

The petitioners will, however, remain bound by the statement made by their counsel today in Court and they shall hand over the actual physical possession of the vacant shops to the respondent-Authorities on or before 01.04.2024.

Any other misc. application(s) also stand(s) disposed of accordingly.
